About the Conference

Introduction: The Conference Organizing Committee (COC) of the 2nd Eastern Africa Agroecology Conference to be held from 25th to 28th March 2025 at Argyle Grand Hotel, Mombasa Road and opposite Jomo Kenyatta International Airport (JKIA), Nairobi, Kenya, wishes to invite all people who plan to attend the conference to register in time.

This is an important conference that will provide a forum to discuss important issues including evidence-generation of agroecology impacts, scaling up agroecological transitions, digitalization in agri-food systems, investment in research and innovation, trade opportunities, engagement of small-scale food producers including indigenous peoples, women, youth and the private sector in agri-food systems transformation.

The conference will involve sessions held in the hotel and field excursions. It will also be live-streamed for on-line participants.
